# Humber Register Privacy Notice

The Humber Register respects your privacy and we will only use the information in the way we describe in this notice. When using your information we aim to be fair and transparent and to follow our obligations under UK data protection laws. Your information is used for administering club membership, activities and competitions and to pursue our aim of maintaining a Register of the existence and ownership of eligible Humber vehicles.

The Humber Register is the data controller for the purpose of General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). ## Collecting your information

We collect your information when you fill in membership application or renewal forms and competition or event entry forms. You can give us your information using paper forms or by email. The information you give us may include your contact details (name, address, telephone number, email address), membership number and vehicle details. When you give us information about another person, such as an emergency contact, you should let that person know that you have given us the information.

If you are under 18 years old, we will also ask for information from your parent or guardian.

## Using your information

We use your information when you first apply to become a member of the Humber Register and then to administer and renew your club membership and provide you with member benefits. We also use your information when you enter club events. For competitions, we will publish some of your information in the programme and the results, which will be in the public domain. Your information is used in these ways to fulfil our contract with you.

We will not use your information to send you marketing messages.

To support our purpose as a Register of surviving eligible Humber vehicles we may keep your information indefinitely, along with that of former members and other owners and former owners of such Humber vehicles.

## Sharing your information

We will share your information with other members in the form of a List of Members.

We may also share your information with service providers, for example to print our magazine, or any other person if we have to comply with a legal obligation.

## Our website

Our club website might contain links to other websites such as payment sites or other clubs. If you follow links to other websites please review the privacy policy for each site because we are not responsible for information you share on those sites.

## Security for your information

Your information is held securely by us. We have taken all reasonable steps and have in place appropriate security measures to protect your information. Your information is not transferred outside the European Economic Area except in the form of the List of Members which may be shared with members living outside the European Economic Area.

## Your rights

- You are entitled to a copy of the information we hold about you and to ask us to correct any inaccuracies.
- You may ask us to stop using your information and to delete it, although we maintain information about your vehicles and their ownership. If you ask us to do this you will cease to be a member.
